Key Lessons from John 10

4. Jesus gives those who believe in Him (His sheep) eternal life and they shall never perish.
5. Although Jesus and the Father are two persons, yet they (and the Spirit) are ONE in purpose, essence, and nature.

What is the testimony of the people in verse 41? **John the Baptist did no miracle, but all he spoke of Jesus about Jesus are being fulfilled.**
