Note: Jesus gives us His peace, and yet, we are responsible to not let our heart be troubled or afraid. We do this by BELIEVING, as Jesus said in verse one of this chapter (cf. Phil. 4:6-7).

In verse 28, Jesus says, "My Father is greater than I", and yet, in John 10:30, Jesus said, "I and My Father are one." They are equally God, but at the time Jesus was speaking, He was in the role of humiliation, while the Father was in the greater position of glory. The issue is one of ROLE, not essence. The Godhead is one in essence, but they have differing roles.

Key Lessons from John 14

1. The answer for a troubled heart is to believe in Jesus.
2. Jesus ALONE is the way to God.
3. Jesus revealed Father God to us. Jesus' followers continue to reveal God to the world, as His Spirit now lives in us.
4. Jesus went back to heaven, but left us His PEACE and sent the HOLY SPIRIT to help us.
