1 Thess. 1:4

Three things that must be kept in Biblical tension...

- 1. God has <u>chosen</u> some for salvation (cf, Eph. 1:4)
- 2. Whoever <u>desires</u> may come (cf. Rev. 21:17)
- 3. Everyone is <u>responsible</u> for what they do with Christ (cf. Jn. 3:18, 36)



1 Thess. 1:10

Three defining marks of true conversion.

- Turned to God from idols v. 9
- Turned to serve God as a slave v. 9
- Waiting for Jesus to come v. 10



1 Thess. 2:6

Eight Negatives

- v. 1 "our coming to you was <u>not</u> in vain."
- v. 3 "our exhortation did <u>not</u> come from error"
- v. 3 "our exhortation did <u>not</u> come from...uncleanness"
- v. 3 "<u>nor</u> was it in deceit."
- v. 4 "<u>not</u> as pleasing men"
- v. 5 "<u>neither</u> at any time did we use flattering words"
- v. 5 "nor a cloak for covetousness"
- v. 6 "Nor did we see glory from men"Live Ready!

Seven Positives

- v. 7 "we were gentle...as a nursing mother..."
- v. 8 "affectionately longing for you"
- v. 8 "we were pleased to impart to you... the gospel of God"
- v. 8 "we were pleased to impart to you... our <u>own</u> lives"
- v. 9 "laboring night and day, that we might not be a burden"
- v. 10 "devoutly and justly and blamelessly we <u>behaved</u>"
- v. 11 "exhorted, and comforted, and charged...<u>as</u> <u>a father</u>"

1 Thess. 2:14...

 Matthew 13:20-21 (NKJV) 20 "But he who received the seed on stony places, this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy;

21 "yet he has <u>no root</u> in himself, but <u>endures only for a while</u>. For when <u>tribulation or persecution</u> <u>arises because of the word</u>, <u>immediately</u> <u>he stumbles</u>.



1 Thess. 2:19 5 Crowns for Believers

- 1.An **imperishable crown** for living a disciplined life (1 Cor. 9:25).
- 2.A crown of rejoicing for being a soul winner (1 Thess. 2:19-20).
- 3.A crown of life for enduring temptation (James 1:12)
- 4.A crown of righteousness for those who love Christ's appearing (2 Tim. 4:8)
 5.A crown of glory for faithful elders (1 Pet. 5:2-4).



1 Thess. 2:19 Christ's Coming – 3 Principal Greek Words

- Parousia arrival/presence (Be <u>with</u> His Royal Highness)
- Apokalupsis unveiling (His <u>power and</u> <u>glory</u> disclosed)
- Epiphaneia manifestation (Revealing of His <u>Divine</u> greatness)



• 1 Thess. 3:1



Philippians 4:11-13 (NKJV) 11 Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content:

12 I know how to be <u>abased</u>, and I know how to <u>abound</u>. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be <u>full</u> and to be <u>hungry</u>, both to <u>abound</u> and to <u>suffer need</u>.

13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.



The concern: The Thessalonians FAITH

- v. 2 "concerning your faith"
- v. 5 "to know your faith"
- v. 6 "good news of your faith"
- v. 7 "comforted concerning you by your faith."



• Trials...

Prove our faith (1 Pet. 1:7)
 Enable us to minister to others (2 Cor. 1:4)
 Mature us spiritually (Rom. 5:3, Ja. 1:2-4)

21 because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were **thankful**, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.



Historical Day of the Lord - Eschatological Day of the Lord

Isa. 13:6 Joel 1:15, 2:1, 11 Obad. 1-14 Zeph. 1:7-14 Isa. 13:9 Joel 3:1-14 Obad. 15-21 Zeph. 3:8-20




• ... the Day of the Lord in the future will be at least twofold in nature. Just as each day of creation and the Jewish day consisted of two phases – a time of darkness ("evening") followed by a time of light ("day") [Gen. 1:4-6] – so the future Day of the Lord will consist of two phases, a period of darkness (judgment) followed by a period of light (divine rule and blessing). --Renald Showers in his book Maranatha: Our Lord Come! p. 33



• 2 Peter 3:10 (NKJV)

10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, **in which** the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up.







What defines the GAP PERIOD...

- Daniel 9:26 (NKJV)
 - 26 "And <u>after</u> the sixty-two weeks <u>Messiah shall</u> <u>be cut off</u>, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come Shall
- <u>destroy the city and the sanctuary</u>. The end of it shall be with a flood, And <u>till the end of the war</u> <u>desolations</u> are determined.

Literally *till the end shall be war; desolations* are determined. – **C.I. Scofield**



 Daniel 9:27 (NKJV) 27 Then he [antichrist] shall confirm a covenant with many [Jews] for one week; But in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, Even until the consummation, which is determined, Is poured out on the desolate." Live Ready!

Four contrasts – Two kinds of people


- Light Darkness

Different Aspects of God's Wrath

- Wrath revealed now- Given over to a debased mind/vile passions (Rom 1:18, 24-28)
- Tribulation judgment The great day of His wrath (Rev. 6:16-17)
- Second Coming judgment The winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God (Rev. 19:15)
- Eternal torment wrath of God poured out in full strength – tormented with fire and brimstone forever and ever (Rev. 14:10-11)

- Elders those who are biblically wise and spiritually mature

- Pastors meaning "shepherds", feed, nurture, and protect the flock (cf. 1 Pet. 5:1-2)



Acts 20:17 (NKJV)

 17 From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called for the <u>elders</u> of the church.

Acts 20:28 (NKJV)

 28 "Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you <u>overseers</u>, to <u>shepherd</u> the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

- **3 Aspects of Sanctification**
- Positional Sanctification (Heb. 10:10).
- **Progressive** Sanctification (2 Cor. 7:1).
- Perfected Sanctification (1 Jn. 3:2).



- 1. *spirit* relates to "God-consciousness". It relates to worship and knowing God (cf. Jn. 4:24, Rom. 1:9, 1 Cor. 2:14-15).
- 2. *soul* relates to "self-consciousness". It relates to the self life including such things as the intellect, emotions, and will.
- 3. **body** it is the physical vessel in which the spirit and soul live.

* [falling away is literally "departure"]
 1. Rapture
 2. Apostasy

and **the man of sin is revealed**, the son of perdition,





Apostasia as departure or departing


- 1384 Wycliffe Bible = Departynge first
- 1526 Tyndale Bible = Departynge first
- 1535 Coverdale Bible = Departynge first
- 1539 Cranmer Bible = Departynge first
- 1576 Breeches Bible = Departing first
- 1583 Beza Bible = Departing first
- 1608 Geneva Bible = Departing first
- 1611 King James Bible = a falling away first

 Just as the Spirit came on Pentecost, so He will leave when Christ takes the church out of the world. The very removal of both the church and the Spirit from the world will release the world to sin as it never has before. – John Walvoord



 As a member of the Godhead the Spirit is omnipresent, has always been in the world, and He certainly will continue to be present during the Great Tribulation. But at Pentecost He assumed a special relationship to the church as its Indweller (cf. Jn. 14:16-17). After the completion of His work in the church, He will resume the relation to mankind He had before Pentecost. – **D. Edmond Hiebert**. _ive Rea

- v. 3 (departure) first "and the man of sin is <u>revealed</u>"
- v. 6 "is <u>restraining</u>, that he may be <u>revealed</u> in his time."

 13 But we are bound to give thanks to God
 always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord,
 because God from the beginning chose you for
 salvation [soteria] through sanctification by the
 Spirit and belief in the truth,



John 1:12-13 (NKJV)

12 But as many as <u>received Him</u>, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those <u>who believe</u> in His name:

 13 <u>who were born</u>, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but <u>of God</u>.
