THE GREAT TRIBULATION

While the entire Tribulation Period is going to be BAD, the last half of the Tribulation is going to be especially TERRIBLE, especially for Israel. This will be an UNPARALLELED time of suffering for Israel.

Matthew 24:21 (NKJV)

21 For then there will be **<u>great tribulation</u>**, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.

What marks the start of this unparalleled time of tribulation is the *"abomination of desolation*" spoken of by Daniel the prophet, as referenced by Christ in Matt. 24:15. This event is that which Daniel prophesied about in Dan. 9:27, in which Antichrist will break his covenant relationship with Israel. This marks the time when Antichrist will commit the height of abomination by going into the rebuilt Jewish temple and declaring himself to be God (cf. 2 Thess. 2:4).

This will signal the very WORST of all times for the Jews. It will be the time of Jacob's trouble.

Matt. 24:15 – Abomination – spoken of by Daniel

Matt. 24:21 – Great Tribulation – unparalleled

Jer. 30:7 – Time of Jacob's trouble – unparalleled

Jeremiah 30:6 (NKJV)

6 Ask now, and see, Whether a man is ever <u>in labor</u> with child? So why do I see <u>every man</u> with his hands on his loins <u>Like a woman in labor</u>, <u>And</u> <u>all faces turned pale</u>?

This time of judgment is going to be so severe that it is figuratively referred to in terms of a woman suffering labor pains. This imagery is used in both the Old Testament and the New Testament to depict the suffering that will be experienced during this time (cf. Mic. 4:9-13).

Isaiah 13:8 (NKJV)

8 And they will be afraid. Pangs and sorrows will take hold of them; They will be **in pain as a woman in childbirth**; They will be amazed at one another; Their faces will be like flames.

1 Thessalonians 5:3 (NKJV)

3 For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, <u>as labor pains upon a pregnant woman</u>. And they shall not escape.

Note that the labor pains description in Jer. 30:6-7 corresponds to the labor pains description in 1 Thess. 5:3 related to <u>THE DAY OF THE LORD</u>. Both of these texts are describing what happens within the context of the Day of the Lord judgment.

The Scripture records two "pregnancies" in relation to Israel and her Messiah. The first labor figure is found in <u>Rev. 12:2</u> regarding Israel metaphorically giving birth to the Messiah in regard to the incarnation at the time of Christ's First Coming.

The second labor figure is found in <u>Micah 5:3-4</u> regarding Israel metaphorically giving birth to a converted remnant that will usher in the Messiah at His Second Coming. The time of Jacob's trouble describes the labor pains associated with the second pregnancy related to the Second Coming.

The context of Jeremiah in writing Jer. 30 and 31 was right at the time of the Babylonian Captivity. Prophecy often has aspects of a near-partial and distant-complete fulfillment. Judah, in the days of Jeremiah, was facing a very DARK time, but was promised eventual restoration on the other side of 70 years of Babylonian captivity (cf. Jer. 29:10-14).

At the same time, the prophet also saw a future time of even greater unparalleled distress for Israel, but once again she would ultimately be saved out of it.

Jeremiah 30:7 (NKJV)

7 Alas! For that <u>day is great</u>, So that <u>none is like it</u>; And it is the <u>time of</u> <u>Jacob's trouble</u>, But he shall be <u>saved out of it</u>.

Jacob refers to Israel. Jacob fathered 12 sons who became the catalyst for the 12 tribes of Israel. Jacob was given the name *Israel* by God in Gen. 32:28.

The unparalleled birth pangs experience found in Jer. 30:6-7 is the climax of the "beginning birth pains" described by Jesus in Matt. 24:8.

Matthew 24:8 (NKJV)

8 All these are the **<u>beginning</u>** of sorrows.

The time of Jacob's trouble is shown to be a UNIQUE time with none other like it. But, Israel will be saved out of it. There will be DELIVERANCE in the end with the Second Coming of Jesus Christ the Messiah Who comes to DELIVER Israel and set up His Kingdom!
