The devil is VERY GOOD at what he does. And what he does very effectively is DECEIVE PEOPLE.

Revelation 12:9 (NKJV)

9 So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, <u>who deceives</u> <u>the whole world;</u> he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. (emphasis mine)

But one reason the devil is so successful is that people prefer a LIE to the TRUTH. The devil enamored himself in glory with the idea that he could take over God's position. Talk about a wrong calculation! That is where pride will take you! The original sin was PRIDE and it was rooted in SELF-DECEPTION. He believed the lie because he wanted to believe the lie. And what was the result? Jesus said: "*I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven."* (Lk. 10:18)

Satan not only deceived himself but ever thereafter, he has been on a mission to deceive everyone else. And he has been quite successful. He was able to deceive one-third of the angels into following him (cf. Rev. 12:4) and then to effectively deceive the entire world of mankind (Rev. 12:9). Jesus defined him as "a liar and the father of it" (Jn. 8:44).

Deception is a terrible thing that often causes irreparable harm! When Satan will be brought down to the lowest PIT, those whom he joins there will look on him with amazement.

Isaiah 14:15-17 (NKJV)

15 Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, To the lowest depths of the Pit.

16 "Those who see you will gaze at you, And consider you, saying: 'Is this the man who made the earth tremble, Who shook kingdoms,

17 Who made the world as a wilderness And destroyed its cities, Who did not open the house of his prisoners?'
