CLIMATE CHANGE HYSTERIA

In the discussion of “climate change,” there is often more heat than light (pun intended). Climate change alarmists oftentimes reach levels of near hysteria, saying that if we don’t do something DRASTIC we only have a few short years before WE destroy the planet. It is clear these people don’t believe God (the only one Who knows the future and has informed us about it in the Holy Bible). They like to think they can play God in altering the weather and, hence, climate patterns. Just for clarification purposes: Scientists are NOT God and neither are Politicians. God ALONE is ultimately in charge of the weather and the climate (cf. Gen. 8:22; Nah. 1:3-4; Acts 14:17).

People are gullible! Someone comes along and breathes the “holy” name of science over something, and masses of sheeple follow along without even bothering to question whether the so-called experts are even consistent in their outlandish claims. The fact is that MANY scientists are wrong about many things much of the time. Just take the theory of evolution as an example. Most scientists buy some form of evolution and build all kinds of so-called “scientific models” upon it. It’s consistently called SCIENCE, but much of it is BOGUS! Climate change theory is often based on either dishonesty (follow the money) or ignorance (follow the glaring inconsistencies).
